The Publican and Pharisee

The Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector is that the two men prayed in very different ways. The Pharisee was a 'holy' man and thanked God that he was not sinful like the tax collector. He reminded God of all the ways he served Him. By comparison, the tax collector stood back and humbly begged God to forgive him for being a sinner. It was the humble tax collector who was righteous in God's eyes.

The meaning of the parable is that God loves and appreciates those who follow His laws and commandments, but those who acknowledge their sinful ways and ask for His mercy are closer to His heart.
